
"Falling Puzzle Pieces" Idea




A spark is seen in the air, but disappears. Shortly afterwards the spark is seen again and this time begins producing pieces falling down. Music starts.




We see the shiny pieces from frog perspective falling against the camera. Speaker: "This is the GNOME Project". Shortly afterwards we pan vertically so the pieces are seen from the side (See next).




As we pan vertically we enter "slow-motion mode" so viewers can grasp the GNOME interface exposed. Everything else defocuses in this mode. Speaker: "An elegant desktop which puts you in control". We are introduced to the shell overview and the searching feature.



We exit slow-motion mode but as speaker begins to speak again shortly afterwards we enter slow-motion mode again. Speaker: "..Delivering a distraction-free environment." Various key designs GNOME does to be distraction-free is shown.



We return from slow-motion mode and enter it again when the speaker starts saying: "...which is easy to customize". The GNOME Extension Framework is shown off with sliders sliding on/off.



We return from slow-motion mode and enter again as the speaker continues: "..and with loads of tools to help you finish your creation."



We leave slow-motion mode once again and rotate the camera to reveal that all the pieces are shaping into the GNOME foot. Speaker explains: "GNOME is free and build by volunteers, so give it a shot."



Once all pieces meet, the picture inverts and the speaker says: "try.gnome.org." The text appears below the GNOME foot at the same time.
