- Was created to build a market for applications on Libre Desktops

- Branded with GNOME to show that GNOME is incubating and leading this effort. (We are leaders)





Where does LAS fit?

- LAS like Flatpak/Flathub is part of a toolbox to invigorate the market move from an distro centric model to a developer centric model.
- LAS can help build relationships with downstreams (Pop!, EndlessOS, Elementary), sister projects like KDE, and important projects like Mozilla.
- LAS can be an effective tool for fundraising
- LAS creates new conversations with the Advisory Board





LAS Plans

- We dropped 'GNOME' from the conference because people were confusing it with just being a GNOME conference and it didn't generate enough interest.
 - We still want to show GNOME as a leader, but we need to find another way
 - The plan was to use GiNA (GNOME In North America) and cohost the two together.
- Given that it is too short of a time frame to target spring, we want to propose moving the LAS to target early September or early November
- We also will have enough time to organize at a pace that won't burn out the team and allow for proper fundraising





What we are asking

- Choice 1 underwrite the conference at \$8k, similar to how GUADEC is done. The idea is this meant to incubate a concept that would pay out great dividends later both for brand, contribution and overall success in the desktop space.
- Choice 2 fund the initial \$3k for holding the conference venue and then we work out the funding ourselves. Everything above will hold true.
